Click on them to go to your profile. Then just tap Unblock. Instagram asks if you're sure; Tap Yes, I'm sure. On the desktop While most of us probably have access to our phones all the time, you can also unblock people from your computer. Instagram's web portal isn't as refined as a mobile app, but it still allows you to control most aspects of managing your account. First, go to the Instagram website and sign in to your account. The website doesn't give you the same selection menu in the mobile app, so you can't just pick up a list of blocked users. Instead, you must type the name of the person you want to unblock in the search bar. Once you've pulled up your profile, click the menu icon (three dots) next to their user name, and then select Unblock that user. Note: Just because you've unblocked someone doesn't mean you're necessarily friends again. If you block someone, it will remove them from your followers and you will be theirs. In addition, according to Instagram, people you unblock will not receive a notification about it. As such, you need to follow them again if you want to see your posts back on your feed, and you need to let them know that they can follow you to see your posts again. Hopefully they won't ask any uncomfortable questions about why you blocked them in the first place, but if they do, well, you can always just block them again. Maybe you blocked your boss or want to stop someone from notifying your Instagram posts, but only for a while? There are many reasons to block and just as much to block someone on Instagram. No matter what your motives are, the steps to unblock are simple. These steps apply to the latest version of the Instagram mobile app and to your desktop website. To remove someone from your blocked user list on Instagram using the Instagram app for all supported iOS (iPad and iPhone), Android (Samsung, Google, etc.) and supported versions of Windows. You can use the ACCOUNTS tab in the Search bar to isolate your search only for user accounts. Tap the profile you want to unblock. Tap Unblock and confirm that you really want to unblock the user. Now you'll see a user's profile where you can follow them. To unblock a user using an Instagram website using a desktop web browser on your computer, visit instagram online in your browser. Sign in to your Instagram account if you're not signed in yet. Select Search. Type the user name of the account or the name of the person you want to unblock. Now select the desired user to automatically fill in the suggestions. Instagram can show a user account unavailable. In this case, you'll need to unblock your account using the Instagram app for iOS or Android; see above. Select Unblock and confirm that you really want to unblock the user. That's it! Now you can follow a user that you just unblocked on Instagram. Yes, Instagram maintains a list of all blocked profiles. To see it in the Instagram app for iOS or Android: You can't access the list of blocked users on the Instagram website, so you'll need to use the app. Instagram profile page. Tap the menu button, then select Settings. Select Privacy, and then select Blocked Accounts. Tap a blocked user to access their profile, where you can unblock them by using the steps above. If you block an account on Instagram, restrictions on blocking someone will be lifted. They'll find you again using an Instagram search. They'll see your posts and stories again. They can track you again (it doesn't happen automatically, though). They can send you private messages using Instagram Direct again. The user will not be notified when the unblock is lifted. If you've previously enabled direct messages from a user, you'll also receive all messages you've sent in the meantime. If you are have not exchanged direct messages with them, the first message will be displayed from the user after they are only displayed as an application on Instagram Direct. Lifewire/Ellen Lindner If you've blocked someone's Instagram, you've followed them too, and new posts or stories won't appear on your Instagram feed. You can't follow a blocked account until you unblock it. To track the user again after blocking them: Search for and open the user's profile on Instagram. It works just as well for iOS and Android in Instagram apps as it does on the web. Select Watch. Trying to unblock someone who has in turn blocked you from Instagram can be a frustrating and, unfortunately, usually fruitless experience. This is because you are blocked from seeing the account, and you have to access the account menu unblock. Your best bet is @mention, say from your account to this user in a private message: tap the Instagram Direct icon (paper plane) on Instagram for iOS or Android. Tap the pencil icon to start a new message. Enter your Instagram username under To, select your account from the list, and then tap Chat. In the @ message box, type the user name for the account you want to unblock. For example, user BarackObama type: @BarackObama. Tap Send. Now tap the highlighted user name in the newly sent message. Open the user profile menu (⋮ on iOS and ⋮ on Android). From the menu that appears, select Unblock and confirm your selection. If a person has changed their user name after blocking you, you won't be able to unblock using this method. If the direct message trick doesn't work for you, here you can try to access the account you want to unblock: Instagram Search. In your Web browser, type the address (of the direct profile page. Find a post from them you've liked. Find the photo or video you saved privately to your account or collection. The above methods may be inaccessible depending on the application and platform you are using. Depending on the app or website, it may not be possible to unblock Instagram profiles that have been deleted or removed because you have blocked them. Their names appear in the Blocked accounts list without being able to communicate with them. If possible, try the Instagram app on another platform. We've seen Instagram on Android able to unblock users that Instagram website and iOS app reported as nonexistent or unavailable. One thing you can do to avoid the state of your Instagram blocked accounts list is to report suspicious accounts and activity to Instagram (Report &t; This is spam or report &t; It's not in the user's menu), instead of blocking users you consider fake accounts. If you have a blocked phone number, your name and number won't appear on the caller ID screen of the call recipient when you make outgoing phone calls.
